This is the 11th consecutive year of these splendid musical treats and they begin on Friday 13th December with a “Lounge” Concert in Grizzly’s Bar, Hotel Piz Buin beginning at 7.30 pm – the tickets cost CHF 85.– and include a Cocktail riche. On Saturday 14th at 7.30 pm there is a Classical Concert in St Jakob’s Church –
